Suggestions for Promoting The Legacy Endowment Fund and Engaging Every Member

*Please share this idea sheet with your entire Mission Team and ask that they help pass it along to their Districts and Local Units!

At Annual Meetings:

- Ask for podium time during meeting to give a Legacy report (or screen time if a virtual meeting)
 - \circ Show the Legacy/Giving video from our new General Secretary and CEO, Sally Vonner
 - Your talking points for after video is shown-

As Sally said in her video, she asks that you join her in making a planned gift by including United Women in Faith as a beneficiary of your will, trust, retirement plan or life insurance policy. You can also give gifts of stock or the proceeds of the sale of property. Contact a member of our Development Staff like I did or me (your conference's Legacy Liaison) for more information about becoming an 1869 Society member through a planned gift.

- Make report uplifting and lively. You may want to ask other members of your Legacy Team to report with you.
- Give the updated amount donated to Legacy by your conference since inception and celebrate. Then give total given by your conference in 2023 – celebrate how close you are to making your 2023 giving goal and encourage gifts to make or surpass your goal.
- \circ $\;$ $\;$ Promote the three giving categories (focus mostly on planned gifts this year) $\;$
 - Legacy Builders monthly giving.
 - Friends of Legacy major gift pledges
 - 1869 Society planned gifts (mention new planned giving pages on United Women in Faith website)
- You may want to ask members to stand who give in each of the above categories so that they can be recognized and thanked.
- Promote new mobile communication platform for United Women in Faith text updates and text to give (PowerPoint slide attached)
- Have a time when you ask for donations to The Legacy Endowment Fund (use attached slide with QR code and text-to-give information)
- If you have not done so yet, play the Giving Jeopardy game as a group (PowerPoint version available upon request)
- Invite a National Office Development Staff member to visit your meeting and speak.
- Ask a respected member to give a short testimony on why she gives to The Legacy Endowment Fund

- If your conference has an E & I Coordinator, consider reporting together so that she can promote the importance of Mission Giving as well.
- Have interactive table display utilizing:
 - New Legacy Brochures
 - New Legacy Giving Envelopes
 - 150 Next pins to give out for donations of \$10 or more.
 - New giving cards
 - Legacy Builder construction hats &/or Jenga game to promote Legacy Builders
 - Giving Jeopardy game
 - Have small prizes/candy available for those who participate in games.
- Have breakout session on Planned Giving and the 1869 Society (PowerPoint available for you to use or invite a National Office Development Staff member to help lead it in person or virtually)

At Mission U or District & Local Unit Mission Studies:

- Ask for time to speak and tie The Legacy Endowment Fund to the mission study.
- Have interactive table display (suggestions under Annual Meetings)
- Host a fun-raiser (suggestions available)
- Play Giving Jeopardy for prizes during a meal or break time.

At Spiritual Growth Retreats:

- Request podium time to tie Legacy into the theme of your retreat.
- Do a devotion on giving read bible verses such as Psalm 145:4 ESV, Luke 6:38 NRSV, James 1:17 NRSV, or Jeremiah 29:11 NRSV
- Ask a respected member to give a short testimony on why she gives to Legacy.
- Have new giving envelopes and thank you 150 Next lapel pins available for donations.

At District Meetings:

- Invite Conference Legacy Liaison to speak at District meetings.
- Have an interactive Legacy table display.
- Include a participatory Fun-Raiser event during registration, lunch or break time.
- Ask for Legacy Fund podium time to give an exciting Legacy update.
- Ask a respected member to give a short testimony on why she gives to Legacy.
- If meeting after your 2023 Conference Annual meeting, show the Legacy/Giving video from our new General Secretary and CEO, Sally Vonner, for those who might not have seen it.

At Local Unit Meetings:

- Discuss Legacy and the giving categories. Share why you give to Legacy and in what ways.
- Promote Planned Giving and the 1869 Society
- Perhaps have program on Planned Giving (PowerPoint slides available or staff can join virtually)
- Have a fun meeting night and host a Legacy Fun-Raiser or play Giving Jeopardy for prizes.

- Promote new mobile communication platform for United Women in Faith text updates and text to give (PowerPoint slide attached)
- If meeting after your 2023 Conference Annual meeting, show the Legacy/Giving video from our new General Secretary and CEO, Sally Vonner, for those who might not have seen it.

On Women's Sundays:

- Designate Women's Sunday offering to The Legacy Endowment Fund give a brief explanation of the endowment.
- Encourage church members to give to Legacy in honor or memory of a loved one.
- Have table display with information on The Legacy Endowment fund and the 1869 Society.

At Conference or District Mission Team Meetings:

- Have Legacy Liaison report on Legacy Fund totals for your conference.
- Talk about the three giving categories highlight planned giving and the 1869 Society.
- For a get-to-know-you time, ask to play Giving Jeopardy game for prizes.
- Pass out copies of this information sheet and ask that they share it with their district officers and local units.

At Church Conference or Jurisdictional Meetings:

- Have an interactive, fun Legacy Fund booth with at least one United Women in Faith member there to answer any questions.
- Report on Legacy at United Women in Faith-sponsored breakfast or luncheon or invite a National office Development Staff member to speak.
- Request that an offering be designated to United Women in Faith's Legacy Endowment Fund

At Quadrennial Jurisdiction Meetings:

- Work with Jurisdiction Presidents and teams for approval of all activities
- Enlist Legacy Liaisons, Steering Team Members & Education & Interpretation Coordinators
- Event / Saturday Evening Banquet
 - Podium time develop talking points that fit theme that we can all use and build from to fit event. (Focus on Planned Giving?
 - Utilize short donor videos if possible or have donor from Jurisdiction speak briefly.
 - Use PowerPoint with donors from the Jurisdiction in each Legacy giving category (1869, LB, & Friends – could have rotating during gathering time and then speak to it – available upon request)
 - Include an "ask" during the event for Legacy.
 - Utilizing QR Code and Text to Give (on screen).
 - Have new giving envelopes on tables prior to event.
 - Decide if other Legacy materials should be on tables as well.
 - Could ask Jurisdiction team if they want to give out Legacy Awards in the Jurisdiction (Similar to Assembly Legacy Banquet categories)
- Legacy Table (or Legacy/Giving table)

- Interactive schedule Legacy Liaisons & Steering Team members to help set-up and take time slot. Try to have the booth occupied at all times resource room is open.
- Promote 3 giving categories.
 - Could ask for 3 tables in U shape, if possible.
 - Legacy Builders
 - Perhaps have Jenga and Construction Hats.
 - Friends of Legacy
 - Giving Jeopardy
 - 1869 Society
 - Trivia game
 - Could also highlight Move for Missions
 - Promote other Fun-Raiser ideas.
 - Accept Legacy donations at booth and give out 150Next pins for donations.
- Offer to give workshop/breakout session on Planned Giving (content available upon request or National Office Development Staff member can lead session.)
- Swag Bags
 - If there are swag bags given out at registration, ask if we can include Legacy materials.

Other possible settings for Legacy promotion:

- Conference or district retreats or Days Apart
- Conference or district officer training events
- Legislative events
