MISSION U HIGHLIGHTS IN PHOTOS!

Let's relive the special moments (and there were many) during Mission U 2023 held from July 21-23 at Wesley UMC, Yakima. Carol Mills generously shares her photos and reminiscences of those blessed days with all of us.



Mission U delegates got a first-hand look at Wesley UMC's Recycling Program- the largest private recycling program in Yakima County. In 2022, the hard-working recyclers, mostly retired UMM, recycled more than 1,041,922 pounds of recyclables, over 520 tons! And, their efforts earned \$33,009.92. Mission U attendees then went out to the Recycling Center to break down cardboard boxes and sort cans. The children and youth especially liked climbing into the trailers and stomping the cardboard.

Mission U delegates got guidance and expert advice from lWesley's Pete Olds as he explained all the components and the process of making Freedom Kits. Each participant got to bring home their completed Freedom Kit to show to members of their local church.



Bishop Cedrick Bridgeforth told us how he came to join the Air Force. While in high school, there was an announcement of an assembly during the 1st period. He'd get to miss 1st period Literature—he was all in. He found a great connection to the African American Air Force Recruiting officer and his future path to the Air Force was set. Each Tuesday, Wesley hosts a Freedom Kits of Yakima workshop. Jane Grandy and Virginia VanAmburg prepare fabric for making the several components that go into the Freedom Kits. Many women from the community come to share in the work and fellowship. There are numerous tasks for volunteers: cutting fabric, sewing, serging, ironing, folding, and then packing bags. Last year, a total of 3,190 kits were sent all over the world, so far this year over 1600 kits have been completed.
