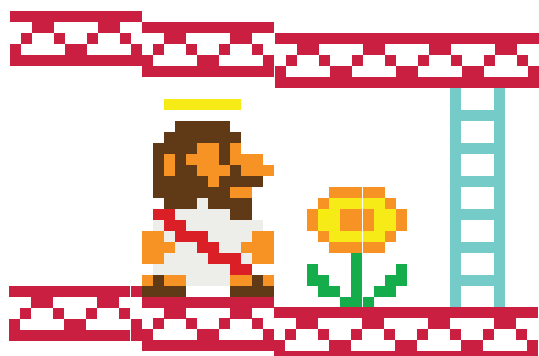
### Event Details
