Community United Methodist Church's Purpose Statement:

As Jesus' disciples, our purpose is to love and serve our community and worship through ministries that transform lives, build stronger individuals and healthy families.

The primary responsibilities of the part-time Worship Leader will be to lead and grow the Contemporary Music Worship ministry at Community UMC.

Qualifications:

1. Faith:

- A solid personal relationship with and a mature commitment to Jesus Christ.

2. Skills:

- Ability to lead band and congregation during Worship.
- Excellent communication skills—verbal and written.
- Ability to meet deadlines and manage several assignments concurrently.
- A self-motivated leader, capable of casting and imparting vision for ministry, possessing relational skills with staff, volunteers and congregation.

3. Personal:

- Energetic, pro-active, goal-oriented, patient, kind, encouraging and positive.
- Exercises good judgment, discretion, sensitivity and confidentiality.
- Highly organized, confident and self-directed. Open to change. Tolerates ambiguity.
- Ability to prioritize and problem-solve in a wide variety of situations.
- Demonstrates history of using principles in Matthew 18 to deal with conflict.
- Teachable, an effective listener and able to take constructive criticism well.

4. Interpersonal:

- Demonstrated high emotional intelligence. Strong interpersonal relationship skills.
- Demonstrated ability to create and sustain a participative and collaborative team-oriented culture.
- Strong interpersonal skills and experience working with people of all ages in a team setting.
- Displays a willingness to seed as a member the staff team, connecting with an supporting one another in ways that fulfill our purpose as a church and its staff.

5. Experience/Accomplishments

- 1 – 3 years' experience in audio, media, lighting & video, preferred.
- 1 – 3 years' experience in managing volunteer teams, preferred.

6. Requirements

- Must submit to and pass a background check.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Pursues being a follower of Christ so that he/she can model and mentor what that is to those around him/her.
2. Provides leadership, invitation, vision, and passion for Community UMC in the area of Contemporary music worship ministries that is in line with the overall vision, purpose and mission of Community UMC. Lead in creating and implementing new worship opportunities which align with the mission and vision at Community.
3. Coordinates with the Lead Pastor and Worship Planning Team to create and lead a well-planned and engaging Sunday worship service. This includes coordinating music for and leading the Sunday Contemporary Worship and overseeing the worship teams (vocalists and instrumentalists).
4. Prepares for and leads rehearsals, which have a dual purpose: a) preparation for Sunday, b) cultivation of Christ-centered community.
5. Leads worship both vocally and with a guitar and/or keyboard.
6. Develops and administers an annual budget for the worship ministry in accordance with the financial policies of the church.
7. Attends staff meetings, when available, and participates in the planning and implementation of church programs that will fulfill the mission and vision of the church.
8. Assists in planning, implementing and leading worship for special events outside of Sunday worship services. (ex. Advent, Lent)
9. Displays a willingness to serve as a member of the staff team, connecting with and supporting one another in ways that fulfill our purpose as a church and its staff.
10. Performs other duties as assigned by the Lead Pastor and/or Worship Planning Team.
11. Anticipates that the duties associated with this position will take approximately 10 hours per week.

Accountability: Reports to the Lead Pastor and is also accountable to the Staff Parish Relations Committee
