2018 Nomination Form

Each year, the Pacific Northwest Conference Board of Church and Society recognizes an individual or organization that has demonstrated a way of living into the legacy of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. This award is funded by local Pacific Northwest congregations' generous giving each year on Peace with Justice Sunday, and includes recognition at Annual Conference along with a \$1,000 award to be presented to an organization selected by the award recipient.

Award amount: \$1,000.00

Nominations are accepted through 11:59pm on April 30th, and should be submitted by email to BOTH Ann Mayer (arsamayer@yahoo.com, Chair of the Board of Church and Society) AND Dave Wright (dwright@pugetsound.edu, PNW Conference Peace with Justice Coordinator).

Complete nominations will be in the form of a letter, clearly including:

- Name and contact information (phone, email, and mailing address) for the nominator
- Name and contact information (phone, email, and mailing address) for the nominee
- A statement that clarifies any relationship between the nominator and the nominee
- A statement, with specific details, that makes the argument for how the nominee has worked to embody the life and legacy of Rev. Dr. King

Additional information is welcome, including but not limited to:

- Newspaper or web-based material that highlights the work of the nominee
- Links and connections to the nominee's website or social media
- Additional affirmations or recommendations in support of the nomination
- Impact statements from those who have benefitted from the work of the nominee
