Seeking a Preschool Teacher

Job Type: Part-time 15-20 hours a week

Pay: \$17.70

This position is responsible for:

1) Collaborate with Director to develop and implement a developmentally appropriate program for young children

- a) In collaboration with Director, develop curriculum that is consistent with Preschool Program of Ministry and NAEYC standards, using Developmentally Appropriate practices and Anti-bias Approach to Curriculum.
- b) Plan and prepare materials for activities to meet physical, emotional, intellectual and social needs of the children, using various experiences and activities such as centers, songs, games, and storytelling.
- c) Provide nutritious snacks (coordinate preparation, set up and clean up).
- d) Collaborate with director and other teaching staff to provide adequate equipment and activities.
- e) Ensure that the preschool equipment and the facility are clean, well- maintained and safe at all times. Report any problems to the Director.
- f) With director and other staff, develop weekly and monthly activities.
- g) Develop culturally appropriate programs and activities.
- h) Develop activities that introduce developmentally appropriate math and early literacy concepts.
- i) Adhere to policies and procedures as stated in the Guiding Principles and FCUMC Staff Handbook.
- j) Carry out routine monthly fire and earthquake drills as directed.

2) Supervise children in the Preschool

- a) Ensure children are supervised at all times.
- b) Organize indoor/outdoor, quiet/active activities for the purpose of actively participating in learning activities with the children.
- c) Build children's self-esteem.
- d) Comfort children.
- e) Establish routines and provide positive guidance.

- f) Provide a safe and secure environment for children to feel comfortable.
- g) Implement positive discipline when required.
- h) Clearly and effectively communicate in a manner that children understand.
- i) Observe children and make notes of progress.
- j) Administer developmental assessments for the purpose of identifying needs, assessing student development and/or for developing Individual Learning Plan.
- k) Discuss each child's development with parent(s)/guardian(s).
- I) Integrate children with special needs in a positive and respectful manner.
- m) Work, as needed, within a multi-disciplinary framework with the Director, therapists, teachers, and support staff to ensure an instructional and therapeutic program.

3) Develop and maintain supportive, cooperative relationships with families, preschool and church staff, FCUMC congregation and local community, through regular, open communication

- a) Collaborates with parent(s)/guardian(s), Director and other staff in the development of an individual education plan for each child.
- b) Discuss identified problems and needs with professionals as appropriate.
- c) Participate in a variety of program activities (e/g. parent/guardian conferences, staff meetings, staff training, planning meetings, program meetings, parent/guardian education opportunities, recruiting activities).
- d) Work cooperatively and effectively as a team member.

4) Maintain program administration

- a) Keep parents/guardians informed of program expectations, program activities and their child's progress.
- b) Develop and maintain current, accurate and confidential child/family files.
- c) Completes and maintains all other required documentation and records.
- d) Develop and maintain daily lesson plans.
- e) Notify director of any needed supplies or materials.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- 1) BA Degree preferred or AA-ECE or Child Development Associates (CDA)preferred. Two years work experience in preschool, childcare or kindergarten
 - a) OR 2 or 4-year degree in any field and 45 quarter units in ECE/CDA and three years' work experience
 - b) OR valid Washington Elementary Teacher's Certificate or Endorsement in ECE and three years' work experience in a "child-related" field with preschool age children from 3 to 5 years old.
- 2) Prior experience working with children with disabilities preferred.
- 3) Ability to relate well to children and their families.
- 4) Supervisory experience recommendation.
- 5) Pass Washington State Patrol Background Check.
- 6) Must have a love and compassion to work with young children.
- 7) Able to lift up to 40 lbs.

- 8) Ability to frequently change position: stand, sit, kneel, bend, and carry children.
- 9) Personal commitment to the Christian faith.
